
Digital **READY** Test

Find out if your strata property is ready for digital TV

By the end of 2013 analog free-to-air TV signals will be switched off permanently and replaced with digital-only signals. Many TV antenna systems will already be digital ready, but some may require an upgrade to be able to receive the full range of digital channels.

One way to find out if your strata property is digital ready is to consult with residents in different parts of the building or complex to see if they are receiving the digital TV channels available in your area. Select residents who have a television that is capable of receiving the digital signal. They will either have a set-top box or a digital TV recorder connected to an analog TV or a TV with a built-in digital tuner.

If any of the residents you surveyed cannot receive all of these channels reliably, your building might need an antenna system upgrade.
